Dian Fossey carried out her research here for 20 years creating the foundation for mountain gorilla tourism.

TRACK RWANDA'S GREAT APES IN JUST 5 – DAYS!!

SAMPLE ITINERARY

- Day 1:** Arrive Kigali. Met and transferred to The Manor Hotel. Overnight, B&B
- Day 2:** Morning City Tour including the Kigali Genocide Museum. After lunch, transfer by road to Ruhengeri. Overnight Mountain Gorilla View Lodge, F/B
- Day 3:** Gorilla tracking. Optional afternoon activity. Overnight Mountain Gorilla View Lodge, F/B
- Day 4:** Gorilla tracking or Golden Monkey tracking. After lunch, enjoy a scenic drive to the twin lakes of Burera & Ruhondo. Overnight, Mountain Gorilla View Lodge, F/B
- Day 5:** After breakfast, return road transfer to Kigali. Depart.

* F/B = full board B & B = bed & breakfast O/N = overnight

Costs based on per person accompanied by local guide:

Please note: Gorilla permits

- Permits are non-refundable and non-transferable and subject to availability at the time of booking.
- A gorilla permit entitles you to one hours viewing from the time you locate your gorilla family.
A total of 64 permits are issued per day, divided into 8 habituated gorilla families. Registration begins at 07:00 sharp.
- The minimum age limit for visiting the Gorillas is 15 years.
- The quote is subject to ANY VAT, levy, fuel or any other industry related increases that are beyond our control.

Costs exclude:

- Gorilla trek permit's **US\$500.00 each** (current rate)
- Golden Monkey permit's **US\$100.00** each (current rate)
- International Flights
- Services of a porter (\$10.00)
- Telephone calls, mini-bars, portorage and gratuities
- Laundry & items of personal nature
- Any additional days added to or deducted off the trip will require re-quoting
- Any accommodation up-upgrades not listed in the above itinerary will require re-quoting
- Any activities not included in the above itinerary will be for the clients account
- Comprehensive travel insurance, cancellation and curtailment
